Note: Elephant Lake is a good lake to use leeches or night crawlers for walleyes. If you are using artificial lures, red or fluorescent orange work best. If you are going to use other colors dark ones work best. When fishing crappies, charrtreuse works well. Smallmouth bass can be caught just about anywhere on the lake. The same is true with northerns.

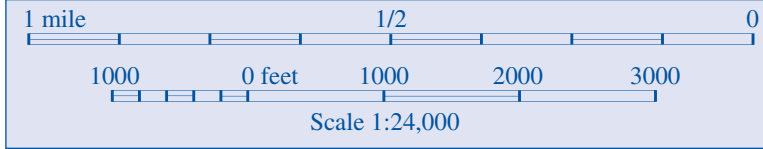

Elephant Lake Fishing Information

Area 1 – The old railroad trestle is a good place for both walleyes and crappies. The posts are still there and the water is around 15 feet deep. The crappies will be right in among the posts. Fish close to the bottom. That way you can also catch walleyes.

Areas 2 & 3 – In the spring of the year crappies can be caught in these areas. A small jig tipped with a crappie minnow or small leech work well.

Areas 4 & 5 – Working the shoreline around Buzzard Island will produce both walleyes and smallmouth bass. It has a good rocky shoreline.
